

ADDI- KNITTING LOOM FALL PUMPKIN PATTERN

A quick and easy pattern for
the knitting loom beginner.

Notes: You may use any circular knitting
loom brand.

Supplies:

- Knitting loom
- Yarn
- Yarn needle
- Scissors
- Filling/Plastic bags

Cast on:

Color of the pumpkin

Knit:

For large pumpkin, knit 90

Medium pumpkin knit 40

Stem:

Switch to stem color.

Knit:

10 more rows.

Cast off.



Next Step: Tug tightly on the stem color and secure with a knot. Next, your going to inside out your work! Bring up the bottom of your pumpkin color, but stop at the stem. Tug on the end of your yarn to tighten it around the stem, but not too tightly, you'll need to secure the layers together!

Working around the stem, use your yarn & needle to pick up your knit stitches from the bottom and the knit stitches around the stem, from your color change. Tug on the yarn after you have finished sewing the two layers together. Inside out your work to the right side of the pumpkin and stem. Finish tightening and closing up the second layer to the stem. Make sure the stem is sticking out. Sew the top of the pumpkin until its closed up.

Now using your yarn needle and adding a new strand of yarn, weave in and out of the knit stitches at the bottom of your pumpkin. Stuff your pumpkin. Using both strands of yarn at the bottom of your pumpkin, tugging tightly and create the sections. You'll do this by coming from the bottom, wrapping over the side and entering just under the stem, down and out through the bottom again. Be sure to tug on your work as you go. Create as many sections as you'd like and
