

B A B Y T U R K E Y P I L G R I M O U T F I T

Supplies:

Yarn: light & medium weight

Size: 2.00mm & 3.50mm

Collar: Using your light weight yarn & 2.0 mm hook.

1. Chain 4
2. Single crochet into second stitch from your hook.
3. Single crochet across. Chain 1 and turn. (A total of 3 sc's in each row)
4. Create 10 rows of single crochets.
5. Chain 7, single crochet in the second stitch from your hook.
6. Single crochet in the next 2 stitches. (A total of 3 sc's in each row)
7. Create 10 more rows of single crochets.
8. Fasten off and create a bow with the loose ends.



Supplies:

Yarn: light & medium weight

Size: 2.00mm & 3.50mm

Hat: Using your medium weight yarn & 3.50 mm hook.

1. Create a magic loop.
2. Chain 1 and single crochet 8 stitches inside the magic loop.
3. Place a stitch marker in the last stitch created and chain 1.
4. *Single crochet 2 in the next stitch, single crochet one in the next stitch following.* Repeat, move the stitch marker to the last stitch.
5. *Single crochet 2 in the next stitch, single crochet one in the next two stitches following.* Repeat, move the stitch marker to the last stitch.
6. Crochet a *back loop fold* in each each around. Moving the stitch marker when you reach the end of the row.
7. Half double crochet around for 3 rows. Move the stitch marker to the last stitch.
8. Crochet a *front loop fold* for the next row. Moving the stitch marker when you reach the end of the row.
9. *Single crochet 2 in the next stitch, single crochet one in the next stitch following.* Repeat, move the stitch marker to the last stitch.
10. *Single crochet 2 in the next stitch, single crochet one in the next two stitches following.*
11. Finish off with a slip stitch. You can even slip stitch around the rim of the hat.

Attach the yarn under the rim of the hat, closes to the center. Chain 13-15 chains and attach the yarn to the opposite side to create a little structure. Keeping the hat from falling off their head.
